

## To remind you of what I said last week....

1. Think of a theme
2. Get enough content for 5 pages
3. Each page should have 1 image and textural content
4. Get text content from copyright free sites like Wikipedia.
5. Get images from a search and use the User Rights dropdown to ensure you are not using other people's work
6. Make a folder called LASTNAMEfirstname\_WEBSITE ASSESSMENT  
So like: ANDREWSjane\_WEBSITE ASSESSMENT
7. Save all your files into this folder
8. Setup your folder structure like you did in your lessons.
9. Move in the html file
10. Move in the css folder
11. Create an images folder too

If you get all of that done you can start to put your content into the template provided.

I have provided the css for you too. Just link to that and tweak as required.

This is a very easy assessment as you've done much harder stuff in class.

Later in the year we may have a crack at a L1 HTML assessment that will actually set you up for a L1 database assessment we do in Year 11.
